# 1. Background

- 1.1 On 11.4.2019, the applicant submitted an application for proposed house cum wetland restoration area (for aquaculture research and teaching), field study/education/visitor centre and excavation of land with minor relaxation of plot ratio and building height restrictions (for "R(D)" zone only) at the application site (**Plan A-1**). On 31.5.2019, 13.12.2019 and 26.5.2020, the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) of the Town Planning Board (the Board) agreed to defer a decision on the application for two months each, as requested by the applicant, to allow time for preparation of further information (FI) to address departmental comments.
- 1.2 On 24.7.2020, the applicant submitted FI including revised wetland restoration proposal and response-to-comments table to address departmental comments. The application is scheduled for consideration by the Committee on 18.9.2020.

### 2. <u>Request for Deferment</u>

On 11.9.2020, the applicant's agent wrote to the Secretary of the Town Planning Board (the Board) and requested the Board to defer making a decision on the application in order to allow two months' time for the applicant to await departmental comments and prepare FI to address further comments (**Appendix I**).

# 3. <u>Planning Department's Views</u>

- 3.1 The application has been deferred thrice for a total of six months at the request of the applicant to allow more time to prepare FI to address departmental comments. Since the last deferment on 26.5.2020, the applicant submitted FI on 24.7.2020 in response to departmental comments. However, the applicant needs more time to await departmental comments and prepare FI to address further comments.
- 3.2 The Planning Department <u>has no objection</u> to the request for deferment as the justification for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33) in that the applicant needs more time to prepare FI in response to departmental comments, the deferment period is not indefinite and the deferment would not affect the interests of other relevant parties.
- 3.3 Should the Committee agree to defer making a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of further submission from the applicant. If the FI submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. Since it is the forth deferment of the application, the applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed a total of eight months for preparation of submission of FI, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances this is the last deferment and no further deferment would be granted.

### 4. <u>Decision Sought</u>

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration at the next meeting.
