Approval Conditions

(a) The provision of fire service installations and equipment in the application premises.

Advisory Clauses

- (a) prior planning permission should have been obtained before commencing the applied use at the site;
- (b) to note the comments of Government Property Administrator (GPA) that under the tenancy agreement No. GPA N588, Fortune Ferry Company Limited (the Tenant) may sublet part of the pier by way of commercial concession for purposes other than the ferry services use with GPA's approval upon receipt of no objection or adverse comment from relevant departments. The Tenant shall submit its application for commercial concession for GPA's consideration under the mechanism in the existing tenancy to implement this proposal. Such application, if received, will be circulated to relevant departments for consideration and any approval given will be subject to terms and conditions based on the comments received;
- (c) to note the comments of Director of Fire Services that detailed fire services requirements will be formulated upon receipt of formal submission of general building plans;
- (d) to note comments of Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene that if the proposal involves operation of any types of food business, relevant food licence(s) and/or permit(s) should be obtained from Food and Environmental Hygiene Department in accordance with the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132). If the proposal involves any commercial/trading activities, its state should not as to be a nuisance or injurious or dangerous to health and surrounding environment. For any waste generated from the commercial/trading activities, the applicant should handle on their own/at their expenses; and
- (e) to note comments of Commissioner for Transport that the proposed use should not affect the pedestrian flow of the adjacent footpath near the Pier.
