Relevant extract of the Town Planning Board Guidelines for <u>Application for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses</u> (TPB PG-No. 13F)

- 1. On 27.3.2020, the Town Planning Board Guidelines for Application for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses under Section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 13F) were promulgated, which set out the following criteria for the various categories of area:
 - (a) Category 1 areas: favourable consideration will normally be given to applications within these areas, subject to no major adverse departmental comments and local objections, or the concerns of the departments and local residents can be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions. Technical assessments should be submitted if the proposed uses may cause significant environmental and traffic concerns;
 - (b) Category 2 areas: planning permission could be granted on a temporary basis up to a maximum period of 3 years, subject to no adverse departmental comments and local objections, or the concerns of the departments and local residents can be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions. Technical assessments, where appropriate, should be submitted to demonstrate that the proposed uses would not have adverse drainage, traffic, visual, landscaping and environmental impacts on the surrounding areas;
 - (c) Category 3 areas: applications would normally not be favourably considered unless the applications are on sites with previous planning approvals (irrespective of whether the application is submitted by the applicant of previous approval or a different applicant). Sympathetic consideration may be given if genuine efforts have been demonstrated in compliance with approval conditions of the previous planning applications and relevant technical assessments/proposals have been included in the fresh applications, if required, to demonstrate that the proposed uses would not generate adverse drainage, traffic, visual, landscaping and environmental impacts on the surrounding areas. Planning permission could be granted on a temporary basis up to a maximum period of 3 years, subject to no adverse departmental comments and local objections, or the concerns of the departments and local residents can be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions; and
 - (d) Category 4 areas: applications would normally be rejected except under exceptional circumstances. For applications on sites with previous planning approvals (irrespective of whether the application is submitted by the applicant of previous approval or a different applicant), and subject to no adverse departmental comments and local objections, sympathetic consideration may be given if genuine efforts have been demonstrated in compliance with approval conditions of the previous planning applications and relevant technical assessments/proposals have been included in the fresh applications, if required, to demonstrate that the proposed uses would not generate adverse drainage, traffic, visual, landscaping and environmental impacts on the surrounding areas. The intention is however to encourage the phasing out of such non-conforming uses as early as possible. A maximum period of 2 years may be allowed upon renewal of planning permission for an applicant to identify suitable sites for relocation. No further renewal of approval will be given unless under very exceptional circumstances and each application for renewal of approval will be assessed on its individual merit.

- 2. In assessing applications for open storage and port back-up uses, the other major relevant assessment criteria are also summarised as follows:
 - (a) the use of sites of less than 1,000 m² each for open storage uses and 2,000 m² each for port back-up uses in rural areas is generally not encouraged, other than sites located in major road corridors, industrial/godown/workshop areas, quarrying activities or where it is demonstrated that optimum use is made of the site. This is to prevent the further proliferation of small sites in rural areas, minimising sprawl over countryside areas and reducing travel trips;
 - (b) port back-up sites and those types of open storage uses generating adverse noise, air pollution, visual intrusion and frequent heavy vehicle traffic should not be located adjacent to sensitive receivers such as residential dwellings, hospitals, schools and other community facilities;
 - (c) port back-up uses are major generators of traffic, with container trailer/tractor parks generating the highest traffic per unit area. In general, port back-up sites should have good access to the strategic road network, or be accessed by means of purpose built roads;
 - (d) adequate screening of the sites through landscaping and/or fencing should be provided where sites are located adjacent to public roads or are visible from surrounding residential areas:
 - (e) there is a general presumption against conversion of agricultural land and fish ponds to other uses on an ad-hoc basis, particularly in flood prone areas or sites which would obstruct natural drainage channels and overland flow; and
 - (f) for applications involving sites with previous planning approvals, should there be no evidence to demonstrate that the applicants have made any genuine effort to comply with the approval conditions of the previous planning applications, planning permission may be refused, or a shorter compliance period for the approval conditions may be imposed, notwithstanding other criteria set out in the Guidelines are complied with.

Relevant extracts of the Town Planning Board Guidelines No. 34C for "Renewal of Planning Approval and Extension of Time for Compliance with Planning Conditions for Temporary Use or Development" (TPB PG-No. 34C)

- 1. The criteria for assessing applications for renewal of planning approval include:
 - (a) whether there has been any material change in planning circumstance since the previous temporary approval was granted (such as a change in the planning policy/land-use zoning for the area) or a change in the land uses of the surrounding areas;
 - (b) whether there are any adverse planning implications arising from the renewal of the planning approval (such as pre-emption of planned permanent development);
 - (c) whether the planning conditions under previous approval have been complied with to the satisfaction of relevant Government departments within the specified time limits;
 - (d) whether the approval period sought is reasonable; and
 - (e) any other relevant considerations.
- 2. Under normal circumstances, the approval period for renewal should not be longer than the original validity period of the temporary approval. In general, the Board is unlikely to grant an approval period exceeding three years unless there are strong justifications and the period is allowed for under the relevant statutory plans. Depending on the circumstances of each case, the Board could determine the appropriate approval period, which may be shorter than the time under request.

- (14) Submission and implementation of fire service installations proposal and/or provision of fire extinguisher(s) with valid fire certificate (FS 251).
- (15) Revocation of planning approval if conditions not complied with by a given date/at any time during the approval period.
- (16) Reinstatement of the site to an amenity area upon expiry of planning permission.

Rejection Reasons

- (1) The application did not comply with the Town Planning Board Guidelines for Application for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses (TPB PG-No. 13E) in that the applicant could not demonstrate that the development would not generate adverse environmental, drainage and fire safety impacts on the surrounding areas or such impacts could be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions, and there were adverse departmental comments on the application.
- (2) The application involved three previously revoked planning permissions due to non-compliance with the approval conditions. Approval of the application with repeated non-compliances would set an undesirable precedent for other similar planning permissions for temporary uses which were also subject

to the requirement to comply with the approval conditions, thus nullifying the statutory planning control system.

Approval Condition(s):

- (1) Submission and/or implementation of (revised/accepted) landscape/tree preservation proposals.
- (2) Submission and/or implementation of (revised/accepted) drainage proposal and/or provision of drainage facilities.
- (3) Submission of drainage impact assessment/drainage study and provision of flood mitigation measures and drainage facilities.
- (4) Revocation of planning approval if conditions not complied with by a given date/at any time during the approval period.
- (5) Reinstatement of the site to an amenity area upon expiry of planning permission.
- (6) Submission of proposals and/or provision of fire service installations/fire extinguisher/street fire hydrant or water tank.
- (7) Paving and/or fencing of the site.
- (8) No paint spraying activities should be carried out on the application site.
- (9) No (night-time) operation during specific time limit and/or no operation on Sundays and public holidays.
- (10) No workshop/cleaning/dismantling/repairing/paint-spraying/cutting/grinding/polishing activities are allowed to be carried out on the site.

- (28) No parking / vehicle queuing and no reverse movement of vehicles on public road(s) is allowed.

- (39) No vehicle dismantling, vehicle repairing or other workshop activities, as proposed by the applicant, shall be carried out on the site at any time.

- (41) No paint-spraying, except within Structures No. 2 and/or 6, shall be carried out on the site.

Rejection Reasons

- (1) The development involving parking/storage of heavy crane vehicles and vehicles with lifting platform would generate adverse environmental impact on the residential uses to the immediate north and in the vicinity of the application site
- (2) The width of the vehicular access to the site is inadequate for use by heavy vehicles.
- (3) The application involves previously revoked planning permissions due to non-compliance with the approval conditions. Approval of the application with repeated non-compliances would set an undesirable precedent for other similar planning permissions for temporary uses, nullifying statutory planning control.

Advisory clauses

- (a) to resolve any land issues relating to the development with the concerned owner(s) of the application site (the Site);
- (b) the Site should be kept in a clean and tidy condition at all times;
- to note the comments of the District Lands Officer/Yuen Long, Lands Department that the (c) Site comprises Old Schedule Agricultural Lots held under the Block Government Lease which contains the restriction that no structures are allowed to be erected without the prior approval of the Government. Within the Site, Lots 2700, 2704 S.A & S.B and 2713 in D.D. 120 are currently covered by Short Term Waivers (STWs) No. 4366, 4367 and 4369 respectively to permit the structure(s) erected thereon for the purpose of 'Temporary Open Storage of Construction Machinery, Construction Materials, Recyclable Materials (including Paper, Metal and Plastic) with Ancillary Workshop and Office'. The STWs holders will need to apply to her office for modification of the STW conditions where appropriate. The owner(s) of the lot(s) without STW(s) will need to apply to her office to permit the structures to be erected or regularise any irregularities on site, if any. Besides, given the proposed use is temporary in nature, only application for regularisation or erection of temporary structure(s) will be considered. Applications for any of the above will be considered by her department acting in the capacity as landlord or lessor at its sole discretion and there is no guarantee that such application will be approved. If such application(s) is approved, it will be subject to such terms and conditions, including among others the payment of rent or fee, as may be imposed by her department;
- (d) to note the comments of the Commissioner for Transport that the land status of the access road/path/track leading to the Site from Shan Ha Road shall be checked with the lands authority. The management and maintenance responsibilities of the access road/path/track should be clarified with the relevant management and maintenance authorities accordingly. Sufficient space should be provided within the Site for manoeuvring of vehicles. No parking of vehicles on public road are allowed;
- (e) to note the comments of the Chief Highway Engineer/New Territories West, Highways Department that adequate drainage measures should be provided at the site access to prevent surface water flowing from the Site to nearby public roads/drains. His department shall not be responsible for the maintenance of any access connecting the Site and Shan Ha Road;
- (f) to note the comments of the Director of Environmental Protection that as the applied use would involve storage of construction materials, mitigation measures as specified in Annex I of the "Code of Practice on Handling the Environmental Aspects of Temporary Uses and Open Storage Use" should be implemented to avoid water and soil contamination from the applied use including: bunds should be provided to contain any spillage of chemical storage and the chemical storage area should be properly hard-paved; drainage channels and an oil interceptor should be installed to reduce pollutants from the site run-off; and materials stored in the open area which may leak out oil or chemical waste should be placed on non-slip heavy duty membrane and properly covered with water proofing sheet to avoid any soil contaminations. It is your obligation to comply with all relevant ordinances in Hong Kong, including the Water Pollution Control Ordinance and Waste Disposal Ordinance;
- (g) to note the comments of the Chief Building Surveyor/New Territories West, Buildings Department (BD) that if the existing structures (not being a New Territories Exempted House) are erected on leased land without approval of BD, they are unauthorised building works (UBW) under the Buildings Ordinance (BO) and should not be designated for any

proposed use under the application. For UBW erected on leased land, enforcement action may be taken by BD to effect their removal in accordance with BD's enforcement policy against UBW as and when necessary. The granting of any planning approval should not be construed as an acceptance of any existing building works or UBW on the Site under the BO. Before any new building works (including containers/open sheds as temporary buildings) are to be carried out on the Site, prior approval and consent of BD should be obtained, otherwise they are UBW. An Authorised Person should be appointed as the co-ordinator for the proposed building works in accordance with the BO. The Site shall be provided with means of obtaining access thereto from a street and emergency vehicular access in accordance with Regulations 5 and 41D of the Building (Planning) Regulations (B(P)R) respectively. If the Site does not abut on a specified street of not less than 4.5m wide, its permitted development intensity shall be determined under Regulation 19(3) of the B(P)R at the building plan submission stage; and

(h) to note the comments of the Project Manager (West), Civil Engineering and Development Department that the Site falls within the boundary of Yuen Long South (YLS) development – Stage 2 Phase 2. The land resumption and clearance programme of the project is subject to Executive Council's authorisation on land resumption and Finance Committee's funding approval of the project. Land clearance operation is tentatively targeted to commence in 2024. In view of the planned YLS development – Stage 2 Phase 2, extension of the planning permission may not be supported in future and any substantial works shall not be carried out at the Site.
