1. Comments of the Chief Town Planner/Urban Design and Landscape, Planning Department (CTP/UD&L, PlanD) (Contact Person: Mr. Henry NG; Tel.: 3565 3950)				
(a)	According to our site on 8.1.2025, only a few young trees of common species are observed along the southwest fencing within the Site. With reference to Plan 6 of the Planning Statement, the proposed swept path of vehicle might be in conflict with the existing trees. The applicant is advised that approval of the application does not imply approval of tree works, if any, such as pruning, transplanting and felling. Application for any tree works should be submitted direct to relevant authority(ies) for approval.	No old and valuable tree or protected species has been identified at the application site (the Site). Due to proposed hard-paving works for erection of warehouse and vehicle circulation purposes, majority of the Site area will be disturbed; consequently, all existing young trees along the southwest fencing within the Site will be affected, and it is not proposed to retain any of the existing trees at the Site.

(a)	Please clarify whether there will be a gate installed at the entrance. If so, please ensure such arrangement will not cause queuing of vehicles outside the subject site;	No gate is proposed at the Site's ingress/egress to facilitate smooth entry of vehicles onto the Site. Staff will be deployed at the ingress/egress of the Site to direct vehicles entering and exiting the Site to ensure that queuing of vehicle would not be carried out at any time during the planning approval period. 'STOP AND GIVE AWAY' and 'BEWARE OF PEDESTRIANS' signs would also be erected to ensure pedestrian safety to/from the Site.
