

Please find the following comments from our Lighting Division from public lighting point of view, for your follow-up action:

1. The proposed works shall not disturb, interfere with or damage the public lighting facilities (i.e. lamppost no. FC4715 and associated lighting cables).

- 2. The applicant shall submit the lighting works proposal supported by lighting simulation to this Division for consideration if there are any proposed modification works to the existing public lighting system or new lighting works involved in the project. The lighting proposals shall comply with the latest Public Lighting Design Manual and Standard Drawings of the Highways Department. The cost for the relevant works should be funded by the applicant.
- 3. The details of public lighting duct crossing at run-in/out shall refer to Lighting Division Standard Drawings.


